

COCK/E of CONSTANTINE - WILLS.

DIRECT LINE :-

THOMAS COCKE of Constantine, Yeoman, made in Nov. 1669 - Proved Apr. 1670.

Giving to Eldest son ROBERT estate in PENALGUY

Naming younger children: Mary; Christopher; James; Nicholas; Thomas; John

Youngest children: William; Walter; Richard and Benjamin to have TRESIDDER

Kinswoman: Alice Pierce

Brother: John Cocke

Brother in law: William Pierce

Wife: MARY

ROBERT COCKE (above) married Jane Jago in Wendron and had a son, ROBERT, baptised at Constantine in 1679. A son, Peter had been baptised in 1675

ROBERT COCKE the son bapt. 1679 married Mary Walters, alias Carne, in 1710 and had a son, ROBERT baptised 1716 who married Radigund Nicholls at St. Anthony in Meneag

" made his Will in 1732 and was also a Yeoman. It was proved 26 Apr. 1733

Naming his wife, MARY

dau. Jane, wife of William Wellmet

son ROBERT to be his executor and receive remainder of estate

bro. Peter (who signed as a witness, which was allowed in those days)

ROBERT COCKE was the eldest son, 16/17 years of age at his father's death. Married at the age of 21 and died at the age of 37, leaving no Will, and leaving children: Jane; Alice; Robert and PETER who was to marry twice at St. Keverne.

SIBLINGS:

JOHN COCKE made his Will 17 Nov. 1685. Proved 21 June 1686.

This would appear not to have been the brother of Thomas Cocke, as I had assumed, but all the sons of Thomas as his cousins.

CHRISTOPHER COCKE Yeoman was most probably the son of Thomas Cocke (see first Will on p. 1. His Will was dated 25 Nov. 1722 and proved 28 Apr. 1726.

PETER COCKE Gentleman, made his Will 2nd June 1752; proved 24 Sep. 1755

          grand. dau. Jane Harvey (mentioning Treculliack and Merther Uny)  
          Remainder to son in law Humphry Harvey, including tenement of TRESIDDER  
          he to be exor.

One other Will:

JOHN COCK Yeoman made his Will 28 Jan. 1709. Proved 26 Apr. 1710

Naming: wife, Dorothy Cock (nee Rayl ?)

John Cock married Dorothy Raile on 28 June 1692. I think he must have been a son of Thomas and Mary Cocke
