SOCIETY RESEARCH.

The Society is one of the four Societies in Australia which will try to help both members and non-members with their research. Members are given this service free of charge and the only cost is the expenses incurred, e.g. photocopying, but non-members are charged on a sliding scale according to how much time it has taken. Non-members are given the option of joining the Society, in which case the fee is waived. This is because research facilities are extended to non-members in an effort to recruit new members.

The amount of research that can be done is limited and more extensive research that cannot be carried out by the Researcher either personally or by mail, must be referred to a professional researcher on a fee for time basis. A list of people who are prepared to do research on this basis are below. Their fee must be negotiated directly with them.

The type of research that will be carried out by the Society is listed below.

1. Research in the Society Library including the Cemetery Index, Index to the Destitute Asylum and Adelaide Hospital Admission Register, Members' Directory, Computer File Index, West Terrace Cemetery Burial Register, searching in the extensive collection of local and state histories and published family histories, checking the indexes of shipping arrivals (the originals of which are in the State Archives, together with the ships' passenger lists).
2. Checking the Abbott and Keain Index at the State Library. (Indexes to State and Catholic newspaper announcements of birth, marriage and death).
3. Checking ships' passenger lists, 1841 Census and Pike's Index of Applications for Free Passage in the State Archives.
4. Checking South Australian Directories in the State Library.

All other records not specifically mentioned above cannot be researched by the Society. Extensive archival research, searching old newspapers, obtaining certificates of birth, marriage and death, will have to be done personally; possibly by mail direct to the record custodian (bearing in mind that Library staff cannot carry out extensive research), or by using a professional record-searcher.
