

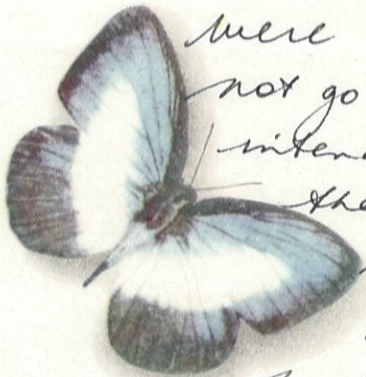

Dear Mrs Hohnen,

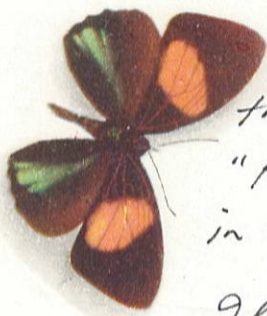
I have just discovered the enclosed un-posted letter & thought that I would still send it with this more recent one.
